How has it evolved?

□ Paris Declaration

- **Indicator 11:** *measures the extent to which the developing country commitment on establishing performance frameworks are realized*
- **Indicator 12:** looks at stronger and more balanced accountability required at all levels

□ GPEDC Monitoring Framework

- **Indicator 1:** *Development co-operation is focused on results that meet developing countries' priorities.*
- **Indicator 4:** *Transparency: information on development co-operation is publicly available.*
- **Indicator 7:** *Mutual accountability strengthened through inclusive reviews*
