Weather and Flood Situation

Weather Forecast

Synoptic Situation: Monsoon axis runs through Rajsthan, Hariyana, Uttar Pradesh, Madhya Pradesh, Orissa and thence northeastwards to Assam across western part of Bangladesh.. One of its associated troughs extends to southeastwards. Monsoon is less active over Bangladesh and weak to moderate over North Bay.

Forecast: Light to moderate rain/T.showers accompanied by tempo. gusty wind is likely to occur at one or two places over Rajshahi, Rangpur, Dhaka, Khulna, Barisal, Chittagong and Sylhet divisions.

District-wise Latest Situation of Flood

Satkhira:

Situation is improving but it will take time to be normal.

66 unions of 6 Upazillas and 02 Pouroshova of Satkhira district are inundated due to the increase of water level caused by heavy rainfall and onrush water from upstream (Jessore area). Water is decreasing as the DC has opened few sluice gates as well as absence of continuous rainfall. The situation is improving.

Due to heavy rainfall and water logging, 8,26,124 people of 1,95,562 families have been affected in these 66 unions and 2 pouroshovas. 25,440 acres crops fully and 18,205 acres partially, 528 km road fully (paka-144 km, muddy-384 km) and 1018 km partially (paka-280 km and muddy-738 km), 30 educational institutes fully and 533 partially, 5.08 km embankment fully and 82 km partially have been damaged. 27,966 families have taken shelter into 288 shelters.

Gaibandha

Water is receding from rivers and inundated areas. Situation is normal now. Low lands of 10 unions of Govindoganj were inundated due to the increase of the water level of Korotoa and Bongal river. Damages are as follows: Union-01, Pouroshova-01, Areas-129 skm, People 1,19,931, Families-2,99,981, Households-2750(Fully) and 18,750 (partially), Crops-40 Hectares (fully) and 134 Hectares (Partially), Road-14 km(Fully) and 35 km (Partially), Educational Institution- 14 (Fully), Embankment-5km (Fully) and 8km (Partially), Bridge-Culvert- 5.

Response from WFP

WFP informed that they are continuing to monitor flood situation and currently undertaking an assessment. WFP already has distributed 40.5 MT of fortified biscuits in response to the flood situation in Tala and Sadar upazila of Satkhira and in Cox's Bazar district. Moreover, WFP will allocate 70.5 MT of fortified biscuits to approximately 23,500 households (1,17,500 beneficiaries) in Tala, Sadar, Debhata and Assasuni upazilas of Satkhira. Each household will be provided 3 kg of fortified biscuits.
